Judy is also an advisory board member of the Celebration of Western Art in Puyallup, Washington and for the FRED OLDFIELD WESTERN HERITAGE CENTER. She is a Signature Member of the International Society of Scratchboard Artists as well as a Signature member of the Women Artists of the West. Her latest awards have been Jurors Choice award for “Hummingbirds” at the Saks Gallery in Denver, Colorado, and the Terry Ludwig pastel of Merit award for the International Women Artists of the West Show and Sale in Rockport, Texas, 2011, the NANCY MCLAUGHLIN AWARD for excellence in versatility by a female artist, 2011, and Best of Show for the Snake River Showcase Show and People’s Choice award for the 2012, 2014, 2016, 2017, 2018 , 2019 exhibit.
