Your bio or artist statement

For the first 30 years of my career as a professional artist I worked as a commercial sculptor. Highlights from that time include the sculptural development of “My Little Pony” for Hasbro Toys, and concept models for several successful toy lines. Movie studio projects were great fun, including a meeting with and portrait sculpture of the dog star “Benji” (a good kisser!), collectable figurines of all the “Star Wars” characters for Lucas Studio and a limited edition chess set of “Fantasia” for Disney. In the 1980’s I sculpted a line of over 200 dog breed key chains that became the top selling gift item in the pet industry at that time.

In 2002 I started focusing on Bronze sculpture entering the gallery scene and Juried Shows. At that time I became a signature member of the Society of Animal Artists, and soon after, American Women Artists.

I currently live on a small ranch in Southwest Colorado with 4 horses, one mule, three dogs and three cats.
